Progress Report: Working with Nexus/Onarga Academy, the walk design is finalized, and a Brick and Engraving Vendor has been identified. By mid-July, we will we send out specific information on how to order bricks. This program allows alumni, former cadets, family members & former faculty, and community members to permanently recognize an individual or group of classmates, patron, family member or special remembrances.

In review, the memorial brick pathway is a new easy public access from the East Seminary Street sidewalk to the existing memorial bench area. The price per Memorial Brick is \$200 for three lines of 18 characters each. This amount includes a tax-deductible donation amount to Onarga Academy, and the costs for the brick, the engraving, and installation.
